I. INTERNATIONAL TOURISM (EZEIZA AND AEROPARQUE)

► INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES AND INTERANNUAL VARIATION (BY %) BY MONTH. NOV 2016 - NOV 2017.






- In November 2017, 194,400 international tourists (+5.2% interannual) arrived in Buenos Aires, marking 16 months of consecutive growth.
- The increase in this month was boosted by the number of tourists choosing Buenos Aires as their only destination in Argentina (+9.6% interannual)
- Brazil and the United States were the biggest markets. While our neighbouring country grew 5.5% interannual, the US grew 18.4%, after two months of decreases.


- Between January and November 2017, 1.74 million international tourists arrived in Buenos Aires by air (+4.6% interannual), 76,500 more than over the same period in 2016.
- Accumulated, Brazil saw a 15.5% increase 66,254 more tourists Pollowed by the rest of the American continent (4.1% interannual), while Europe saw a slight decrease (-1.4%).

II. NATIONAL TOURISM IN HOTELS

ARGENTINE TOURIST HOTEL STAYS. NOVEMBER 2016 - NOVEMBER 2017





- With 266,461 Argentine tourists staying in hotels (+4.3%), November was the second highest month of the year, after July, for hotel stays in Buenos Aires, and saw the highest number of stays for November in the last ten years.
- In the period January-November 2017, 2,637,420 national tourists stayed in hotels in the city (+4.6%), making the first 11 months of the year the best since 2007.
