I. INTERNATIONAL TOURISM > EZEIZA AND JORGE NEWBERY

INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES AND INTERANNUAL VARIATION (BY %) BY MONTH. OCTOBER 2017 - OCTOBER 2018.





- In October 2018, 178,442 international tourists arrived in Buenos Aires by air (+0.8%), making it the seventh consecutive month of interannual growth. A significant proportion of the rise came from Chile (+11.6%) and Rest of the World (+18%). The distant markets most notable were China, Japan, Australia and New Zealand.



- Over the first ten months of the year, international arrivals by air totalled 1.6 million, up 4% on the same period in 2017.
- The markets leading the upturn are Rest of the World market led the increase with 22,400 more tourists, or +19.2% i.a., particularly from China, Japan and Australia, followed by Europe (15,000 more visitors; +5.1%), Brazil (up by 9,000 visitors, or +2.1%) and the US and Canada (8,700 additional visitors).
- From January to October, overnight stays totalled 15.2 million (+7.8%, or one million more nights.)



II. NATIONAL TOURISM IN HOTELS

ARGENTINE TOURIST HOTEL STAYS. OCTOBER 2017 - OCTOBER 2018





- In October, 227,833 Argentine tourists stayed in hotels in Buenos Aires (-9.8% i.a.) against a background of a drop in purchasing power and a slowdown in economic activity.
- The total number of overnight stays by Argentine tourists was 485,400 (-13.8%).
- The occupancy rate for hotel rooms in Buenos Aires was 65.7%, (-0.6 percentage points against August 2017).
